INTENDED USE


This collar is designed to restrict flexion, extension, lateral bending and axial rotation promoting patient recovery.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Pre-form collar prior to fitting. To preform front panel, roll panel sides inward with both hands.
- 2. To pre-form back panel, roll panel into a cylinder.





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SIZING

With patient in NEUTRAL ALIGNMENT, measure the vertical distance from the tip of the chin to the top of the shoulder (A). Select the correct collar by referring to the size guide below. **Note:** cervical region (head, neck and back) of the patient must be in neutral alignment before a measurement is taken.

- 3. To apply patient must be in NEUTRAL ALIGNMENT. Slide the front portion of the collar up the patient's neck and properly position the chin support. Note: before applying collar, verify that the proper size is selected.
- 4. Center the back portion onto the patient's neck. With the front portion properly secured, use the bilateral hook and loop straps and fasten the portions together.





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
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
